**EXECUTIVE DIRECTIVE NO. 6
REVIEW OF STATE CONTRACTS TO DETERMINE OUTSOURCING OF JOBS TO
OTHER COUNTRIES**

TO: All Cabinet Secretaries

Pursuant to Article III, Sec 5 of the Constitution of North Carolina, I hereby direct all cabinet secretaries to conduct a review of all state contracts administered by their agencies for the purpose of determining if any jobs related to the contracts have been outsourced to other countries. Additionally, I direct such inquiries to be made as part of the Request for Proposal (RFP) process prior to the awarding of any contract.

This directive shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect until rescinded.

A copy of this directive is being sent to the Lieutenant Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speakers of the House of Representatives for their information.
