AN ACT CONCERNING RETENTION OF JOBS IN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to (1) require government privatization contracts to prohibit outsourcing, (2) prohibit outsourcing in state purchasing,

and (3) require employers relocating at least twenty-five per cent of their workforce outside the state to provide at least six months written notice.

Statement of Purpose:

To help keep jobs in Connecticut and stem the economic damage caused by outsourcing.
