AN ACT CONCERNING INDIVIDUALS WHO WORK ON STATE CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2004*) Each contract entered
2 into by a state agency shall include a provision requiring that all
3 employees of the contractor who will be implementing the contract are
4 United States citizens or legal aliens, except where the contractor is
5 unable to find a United States citizen or legal alien possessing the
6 expertise or skills required for the performance of the contract.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2004</i>

Statement of Purpose:

To require that workers on state contracts be United States citizens or legal aliens, or have some specialty for which such workers cannot be found, in order to prohibit companies that receive state contracts from recruiting workers who live outside the United States and are not United States citizens.
